Applicants understand that the GHS, in its sole discretion, will make the final decision regarding Cassie's future home and agree to remain respectful towards the staff and volunteers at GHS while partaking in the process. Regrettably due to lack of resources, GHS is unable to keep individual applicants updated on the status of their application, however all applicants will be notified in if their application is successful or not at the conclusion of the adoption.
